Rules and Regulations

- At our insurance company's insistence, livestock exhibitors must provide proof of liability insurance or entries will have to be refused.
- Unlicensed drivers will not be allowed to operate motorized vehicles in the parade.
- Entries to be phoned to the fair office (613-835-2766) or to Eleanor Hodges at 613-833-2792 by Friday, August 1, 2008. The parade will begin in the field on Smith Road, adjacent to Smith Ridge Meadows (same as last year).
- Theme of this year's Fair is "A Family Affair". You may refer to the theme when you design your float entries, but it is not compulsory.
- Each entry to supply its own power and wagon (or vehicle) for the float, maximum height of 12 feet.
- Judging will be based equally on creativity, interest and overall appearance.
- All judged entries should be in place by 9:30 am and judging will commence at 10:00 am. All non-judged entries to be in place at 10:30 am. Please note that costumed children and decorated pets and bicycles need not be present before 10:15 am.
- The parade will start at 11:00 am, rain or shine.
- The parade finishes at the Delson Drive Entrance to the Fair grounds.
- Tossing objects or candy at the crowds is not permitted. However, hand delivery of such items is encouraged.

A large rosette ribbon will also be given to the best float entry.

Other Classes

1. Children's Costume Parade - \$4.00 and a ribbon will be awarded to each worthy entry. (*Entrant must participate in the Fair Parade*).
2. Decorated bicycles and wagons 6-12 years of age: \$2.00 and a ribbon will be awarded to each worthy entry. (*No tricycles please*)
3. Decorated Pets, 6-12 years of age. **Must be on a leash or in a cage and on a wagon if required for transportation.** \$2.00 and a ribbon to all worthy entrants.
4. Horse and rider: Ribbons only.
5. Horse drawn vehicles: Ribbons only.

6. Antique tractors and/or farm implements: Ribbons only.
7. Antique cars, trucks or jeeps: Ribbons only.
