Rules of Play

1. The Navan Fair Truck Raffle will take place starting on May 13, 2022 until tickets are sold out, or August 7, 2022 at 1:00pm EDT.
2. A maximum of 1,200 tickets will be sold.
3. Must be 18 years of age or older to participate.
4. Ticket buyers must be in Ontario at the time of purchase.
5. Tickets are \$100 each.
6. 2 Early Bird prizes of \$1,000 (\$2,000 total) will be held on the following dates.
 - EB#1: Deadline: May 31st, 2022 at 11:59pm EDT, draw on June 1st, 2022 at 7:00pm EDT
 - EB#2: Deadline: July 14th 2022 at 11:59pm EDT, draw on July 15th, 2022 at 7:00pm EDT
7. The Grand Prize draw will take place on August 7th 2022 at 3:00pm EDT.
 - Grand Prize deadline: August 7th at 1:00pm EDT.

8. Tickets will be sold in person and online at navanfairtruckraffle@gmail.com.
9. After purchasing a ticket, buyers will be given a receipt which contains their allocated ticket number. All ticket buyers will be required to give their name, address, email and phone number for each ticket purchased.
10. A member of our executive board will draw the winning ticket.
11. The winning number will be announced on the www.navanfair.com website and Facebook page. All winners will be notified by phone. Winners agree to the use of their name and photo for announcement/publicity purposes by The CTAS/ Navan Fair.
12. The winner may claim their prize by contacting a Navan Fair board director. The ticket must then be brought to the Navan Fair office located at 1279 Colonial Rd. Navan, Ontario K4B 1N1 at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. Winner must have the original winning ticket and no copies.
13. The winner is responsible for contacting the dealership, Myers Orleans Chevrolet, Buick, GMC located at 1875 St. Joseph Blvd. Orleans, ON K1C 7J2 (613)834-6397 to arrange pickup of their prize.
14. The CTAS is responsible for the costs associated with the transfer of ownership of the truck.
15. It is the responsibility of the winner to license and obtain insurance for the truck prior to taking ownership.

16. Prize(s) must be claimed within six (6) months after the final draw date after which time the CTAS will consult with the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) on how to proceed.
